

Information about processing of personal data at Atest Gaz A.M. Pachole sp. j.

In connection to processing of personal data and acting on grounds of Article 13, para 1 and 2 of the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation) (Text with EEA relevance), we kindly inform that the entity **Atest Gaz A. M. Pachole sp. j.** with the official address at **3, Spokojna St., Gliwice** with the phone number **+48 32 238 87**, the fax number **+48 32 234 92 71** and the e-mail address contact@atestgaz.pl.

Personal data of natural persons are processed for the following purposes:

- / execution of the personnel recruitment process,
- / distribution of information about our products, promotion campaigns and the most recent offers,
- / development of quotations and smooth execution of concluded contracts,
- / fulfillment of tax obligations,
- / claiming for damages under terms of the Civil Code regulations if such claims may appear.

The legal background for processing of personal data is Article 6 of the aforementioned Regulation.

Personal data can be transferred to external entities for the following purposes:

- / collection of information necessary for development of quotations and conclusion of contracts,
- / fulfill other obligations imposed by applicable legal regulations in force,
- / safeguarding of proprietary rights attributable to **Atest Gaz A. M. Pachole sp. j.** under terms of applicable regulations in force,
- / protection of justified interests attributable to **Atest Gaz A. M. Pachole sp. j.** in terms of applicable regulations on protection of personal data.

Personal data of natural persons shall be stored during the time of contract execution but not longer than to the day when the time limit for possible claims arising from or connected to completed contract shall expire.

Data subjects shall be entitled to the following:

- / access to the content of proprietary personal data with the right to rectification, erasure, restriction of processing, right to data portability, to make objections and to withdraw the person's consent for data processing at any moment,
- / move a claim to the President of the Office for Protection of Personal Data (UODO) when a data subject is in position that the way of personal data processing by the data controller is in breach with regulations of the General Data Protection Regulation (RODO).

Data subjects shall be obligatorily informed about the fact and the scope of personal data protection in the following cases:

- / execution of the personnel recruitment process,
- / conclusion and smooth execution of contracts,
- / claiming for damages under terms of the Civil Code regulations if such claims may appear.

In any other cases any information about processing of personal data shall be provided under voluntary terms.
